NOTE TAKING & REPORTING CONTEST

Transcription time increased - Stricter evaluation

The experience from previous competitions has shown us that the rating in the Intersteno competition Note taking & reporting (NT) was too generous. It meant that many high scores were achieved and that many ex-aequo-positions appeared in the results lists.

To be able to more accurately assess the summaries made by the participants, a stricter evaluation is necessary for the NT contest in Cagliari.

- 1° In order to receive all the credit points belonging to a key sentence in the model summary, the content of this key sentence should be fully (100%) represented in the participant's summary (synonyms are allowed).
- 2° In order to receive still half the credit points belonging to a key sentence in the model summary, at least half ($\geq 50\%$) of the content of this key sentence should be represented in the participant's summary.
- 3° No credit points can be awarded if less than half ($< 50\%$) of the content of a key sentence is represented in the participant's summary and/or if that summary conflicts with the key sentence.

There are no changes necessary in the evaluation of the literal transcription of title and section headings in a participant's summary. Here applies article 17.2 of the Regulations for the Intersteno competitions.

It will be 90 minutes transcription time instead of the previous 60 minutes (see Intersteno competition rules).

Points 1 to 3 will, of course, be further elaborated in the instructions for jury and correctors/valuers.
